## Summary Principles of Data Privacy

There are a number of data privacy regulations that must be observed when handling personal data.

The following seven principles will help you ensure that your conduct is correct:



## Lawfulness, fairness, transparency

Data must be processed legally – e.g., on the basis of consent. All data subjects must be properly informed of the purpose, scope, and nature of the data processing.



**Purpose limitation** Personal data may only be processed for clear, defined, and legitimate purposes.



**Data minimisation** Only data that is actually required for the specified purpose may be processed.



Accuracy

Data must be processed in a way that is objectively correct. Data subjects must be able to exercise their right to the correction or deletion of their data at any time.



**Storage limitation** Personal data may only be stored for as long as is absolutely necessary.



## Integrity and confidentiality

Appropriate technical and organizational measures must be taken to protect personal data from accidental or intentional deletion, alteration, transfer, granting of access, or loss.



## Accountability

The responsible company is required to provide proof of compliance with the six above-mentioned principles.
