Private Healthcare

All staff are given access to free private healthcare, benefitting from easy-to-book appointments and shorter waiting times.

Outstanding Context

Workload Management

With lower than average pupil to staff ratios, class sizes are reasonable. We also ensure that our staff have lower than national levels of lesson loadings, this gives staff more time to plan and assess. Meetings are purposeful and CPD is bespoke. Staff are not expected to invigilate any exams unless urgent.

Staff Wellbeing Days

Staff are offered two wellbeing days per academic year where they can work from home.

A new, bright and airy modern building with excellent teaching facilities. Teachers benefit from the use of the on-site gym and swimming pool.
